### Scope of Study / Project Purpose & Need





#### Scope

 Evaluate an off-system multi-use trail that would connect Wooton Park in the City of Tavares to Tremain Street in the City of Mount Dora.

#### **Purpose**

 Provide a safe, comfortable, and accessible paved facility for bicyclists, pedestrians, and other non-motorized users of all ages and abilities between Tavares and Mount Dora.

#### Need

- Gap in regional trail network
- Lack of safe, comfortable, and accessible pedestrian and bicycle facilities



### **Study Area / Limits**






- From Disston Avenue to Tremain Street

- Variations along eastern end






















# Proposed Planning Concept Alt B Typical Section A-A 14-foot Trail along Railroad from Disston Avenue to Dora Avenue






### Proposed Planning Concept Alt B Typical Section B-B 14-foot Trail along Railroad from Dora Avenue to Tremain Street






