This public hearing is being held to afford persons the opportunity to express their views relative to the proposed access management changes and roadway widening along this section of CR 484.





- To receive public input about the proposed changes






Project Limits

Project Length 0.75 miles










CR 484 East and West of the I-75 Bridge






Typical Sections



CR 484 Under the I-75 Bridge






Proposed Median Modifications

Access Management is a comprehensive approach to the management and regulation of driveways, medians, median openings, traffic signals, and freeway interchanges.


The goal of access management is to limit and separate traffic conflict points. By reducing conflicts, we can <u>improve safety</u> and <u>increase traffic capacity</u>.






Access Management Criteria


- Access Management reduces conflict points and crashes
 - Full Median Opening = 18 Major & 10 Minor Conflict Points
 - One-Way Directional Opening = 2 Major & 4 Minor Conflict Points
 - Two-Way Directional Opening = 4 Major & 8 Minor Conflict Points
 - Full Closure (Right Turn Only) = 2 Minor Conflict Points

Proposed Median Modifications – East of I-75




