A1A on Wednesday, March 30, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to enhance pedestrian safety and improve traffic operations along International Speedway Boulevard (U.S. 92) from the Halifax River Bridge to State Road (S.R.) A1A. Following a public hearing in October 2020, FDOT revised the plans to address community concerns. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
