
Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing plans to upgrade the northbound Interstate 75 (I-75) rest area in Marion County. The purpose of the project is to update the facility to better serve travelers.

The rest area will be reconstructed to bring the building up to current standards. The project will also construct additional picnic shelters and an area for pets, as well as a maintenance shed.

Parking capacity will be increased for passenger vehicles, recreational vehicles, and trucks. The design will also accommodate future parking expansion.

The project will include coordination with Marion County Utilities to reconstruct water and wastewater systems at the facility as well.



The FPID number for this project includes the design for both the northbound and the southbound rest areas. The cost listed for design in the chart below includes both rest areas. Construction of the rest areas will be completed and funded separately. Currently, construction for the northbound rest area is funded in 2023. The Department is still seeking funding for the construction of the southbound rest area.
