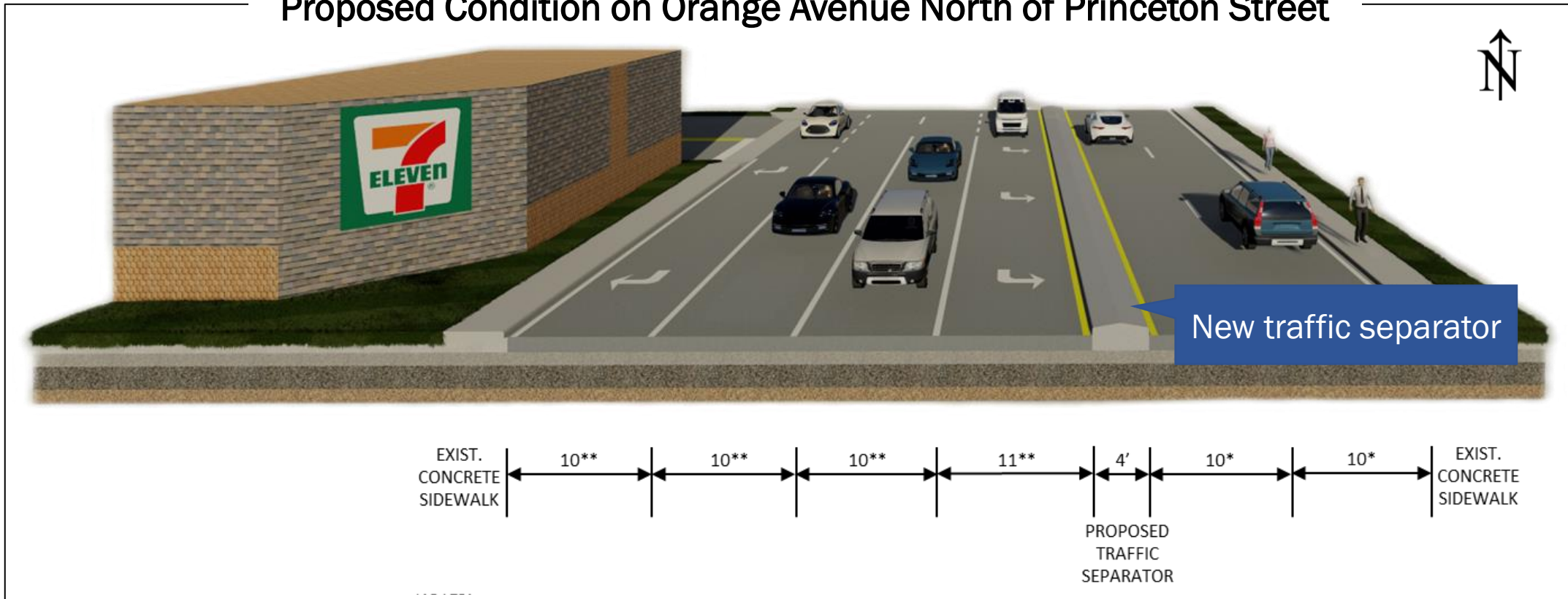


- Enhance safety

- Reconstruct and upgrade traffic signals
- Improve signal timing
- Construct traffic separator
- Upgrade pedestrian curb ramps

Design – Completion expected fall 2022

Right of Way – Within existing

Construction – Expected start spring 2023 at an estimated cost of \$817,000

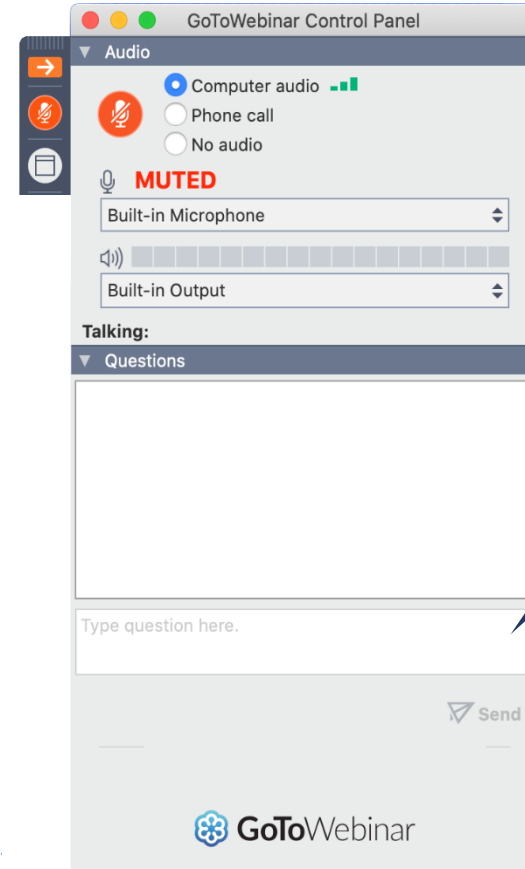
