Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441) Intersection Improvements, Orange County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans at the intersection of Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441) and Clarcona-Ocoee Road on Tuesday, February 1, 2022, at 5:30 p.m.. The purpose of this project is to reconstruct and upgrade the existing traffic signal at the intersection to include new poles, new signal heads with enhanced visibility for drivers, and new pedestrian signals. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
