WHY ARE WE HERE?

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), in partnership with the City of Orlando, is conducting a concept development study on Robinson Street (State Road (S.R.) 526) *to further refine possible improvements identified in the planning phase of the study. The purpose of the study is to enhance safety and comfort of multimodal travel along and across the Robinson Street corridor.* The study area includes Robinson Street from North Hughey Avenue to Crystal Lake Drive/Maguire Boulevard.

The study team presented the alternatives during a series of public meetings in October 2017. Since then, the team has refined the alternatives and selected a set of improvements.

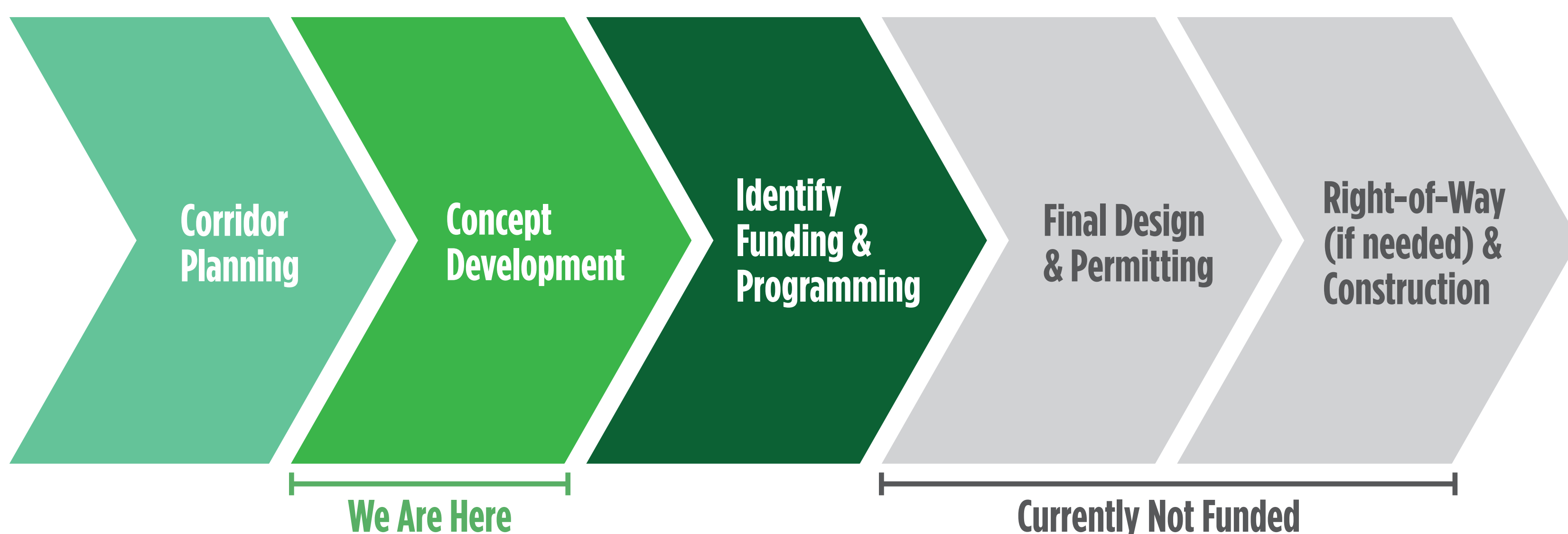
