DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

Rockefeller Drive from S.R. A1A (South Atlantic Avenue) to the Halifax River

Volusia County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will implement drainage improvements to the existing State Road (S.R.) A1A (South Atlantic Avenue) drainage outfall system located at Rockefeller Drive in Ormond Beach, Volusia County. Work includes the pipelining and repair of a storm drain along Rockefeller Drive that carries excess rain and ground water from S.R. A1A to the Halifax River. Additional enhancements include milling and paving at various locations on Rockefeller Drive.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Throughout construction, motorists should expect intermittent daytime road closures and detours on Rockefeller Drive at the following intersections: S.R. A1A, Grandview Avenue, Wild Olive Avenue, Cedar Street, Hollywood Street, Pinewood Street, Magnolia Street, and Riverside Drive. These closures will allow the project team to perform work on drainage structures within the intersections. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct motorists through the detours.

The construction schedule may change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. Always be cautious and avoid distractions when driving through a work zone.
