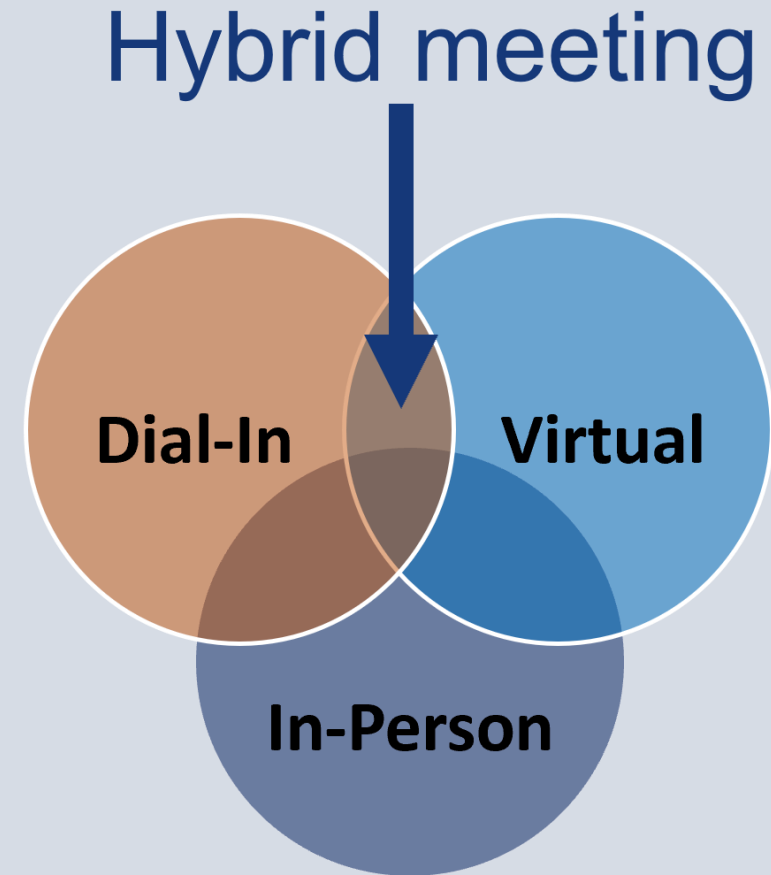

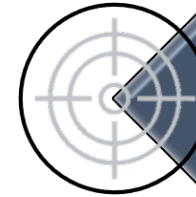

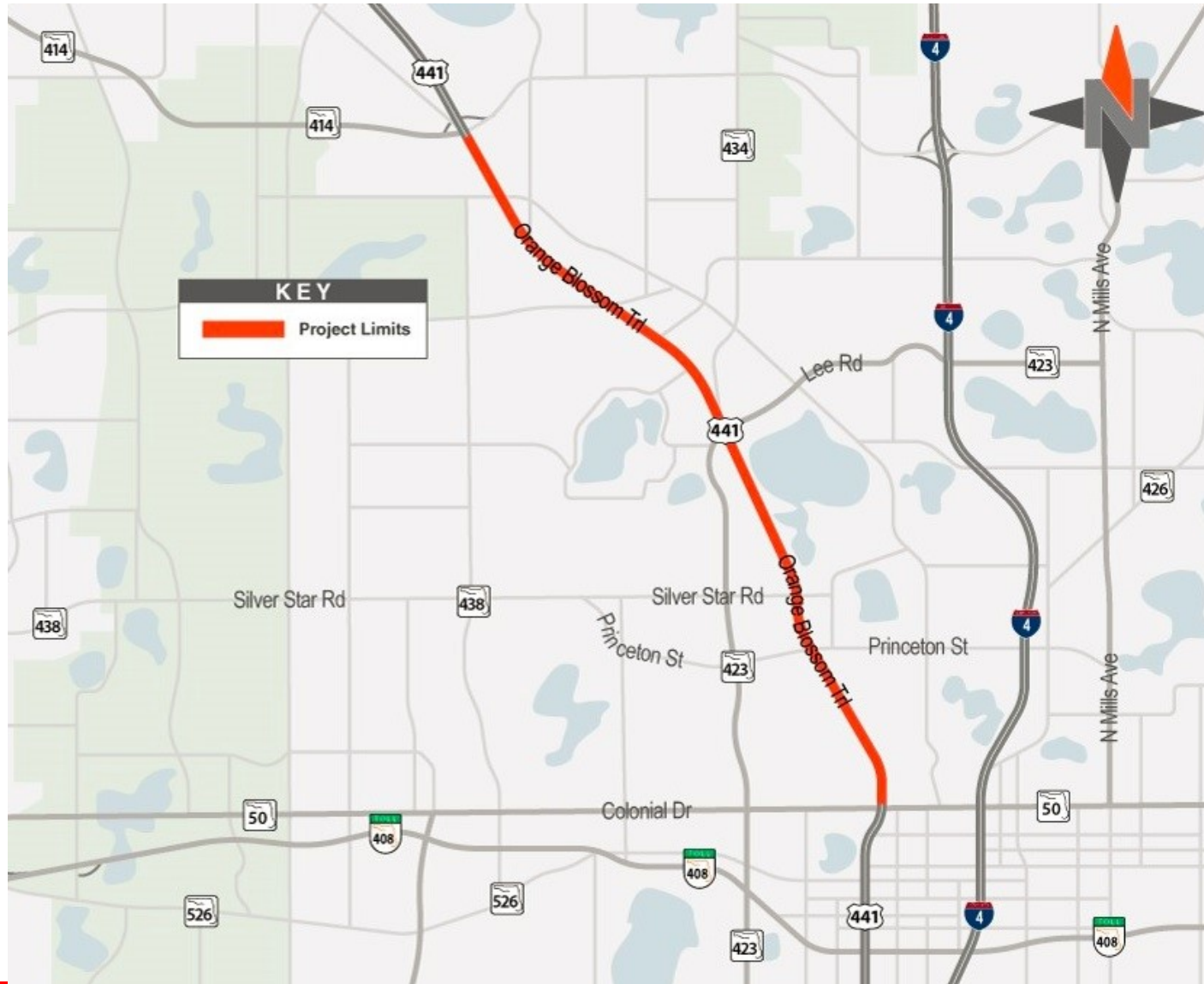

Project Improvements



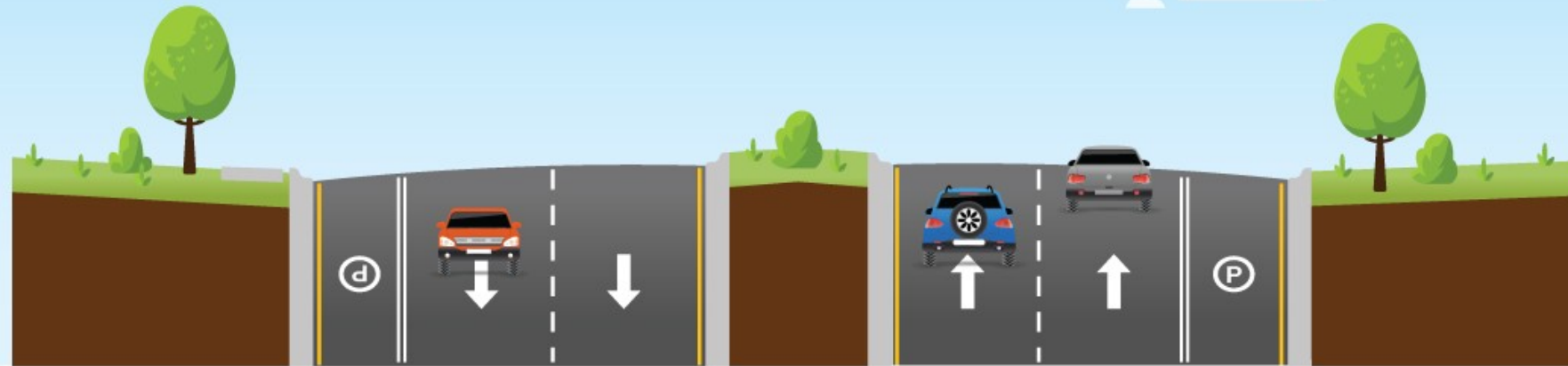
- Directional medians

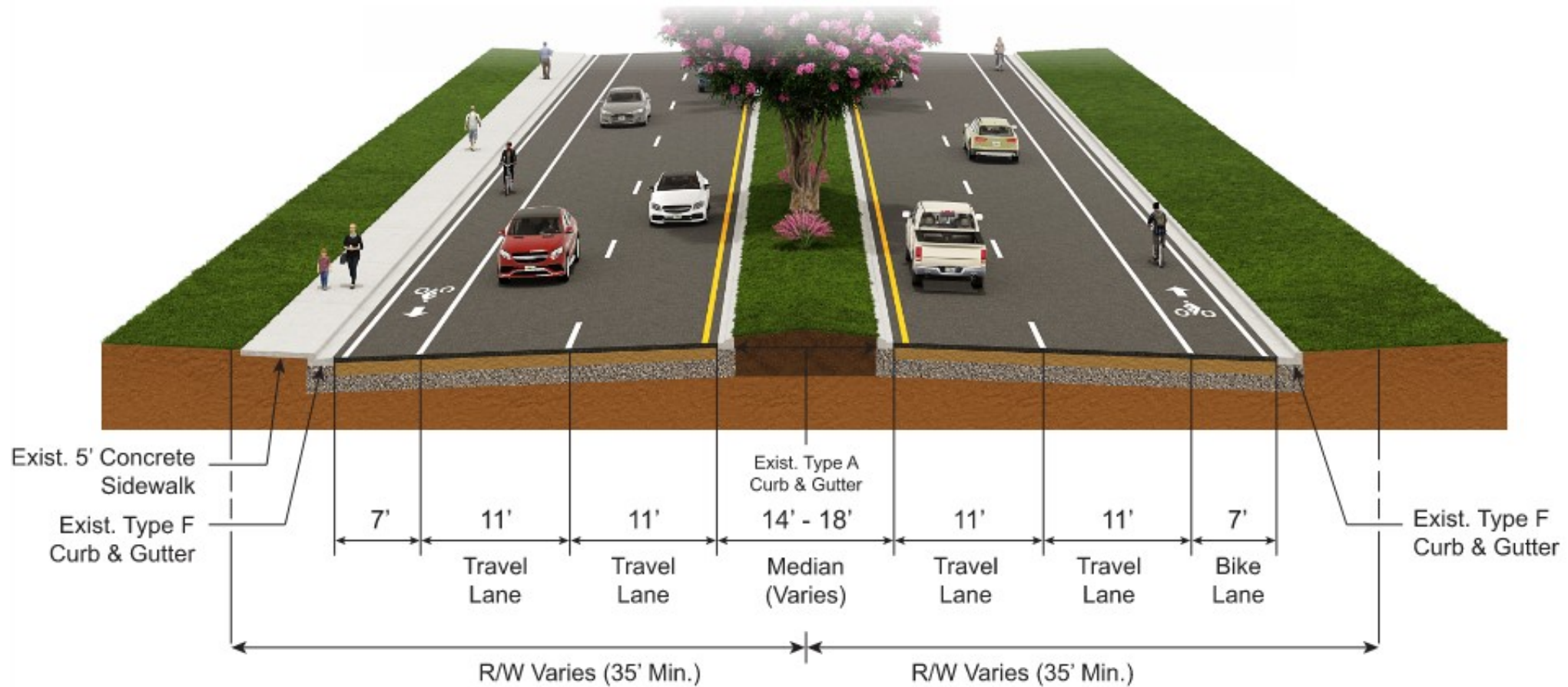

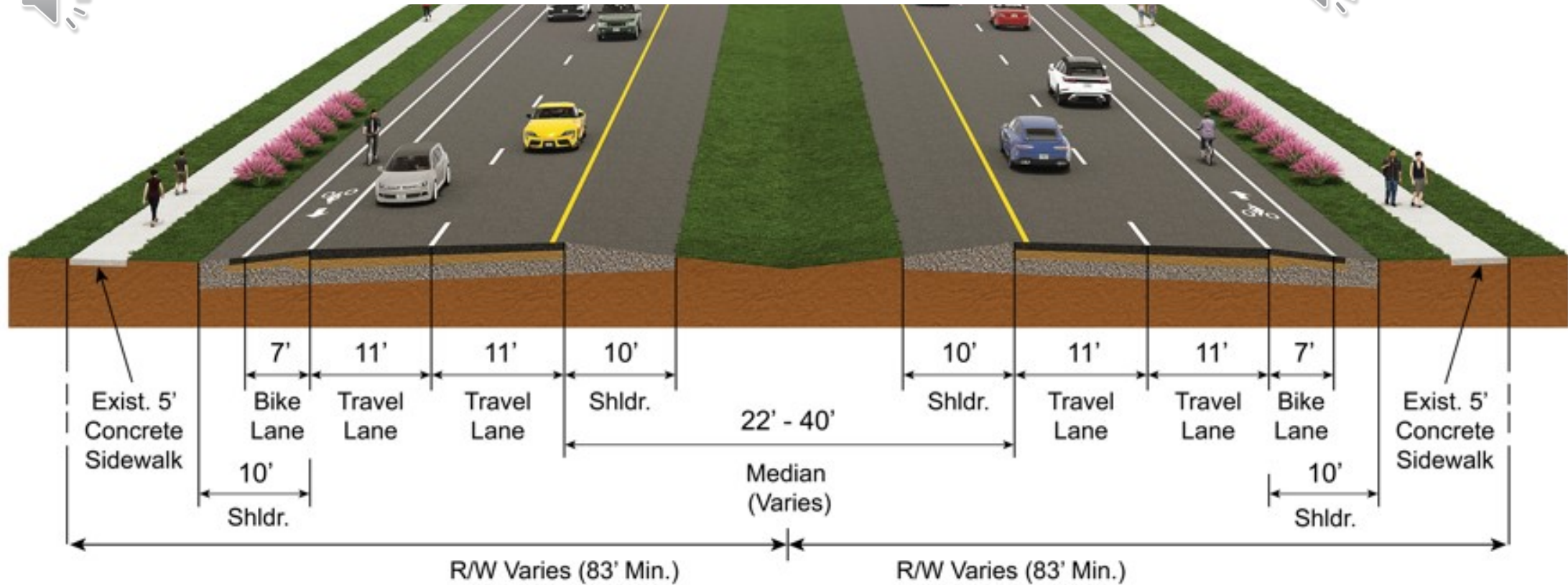

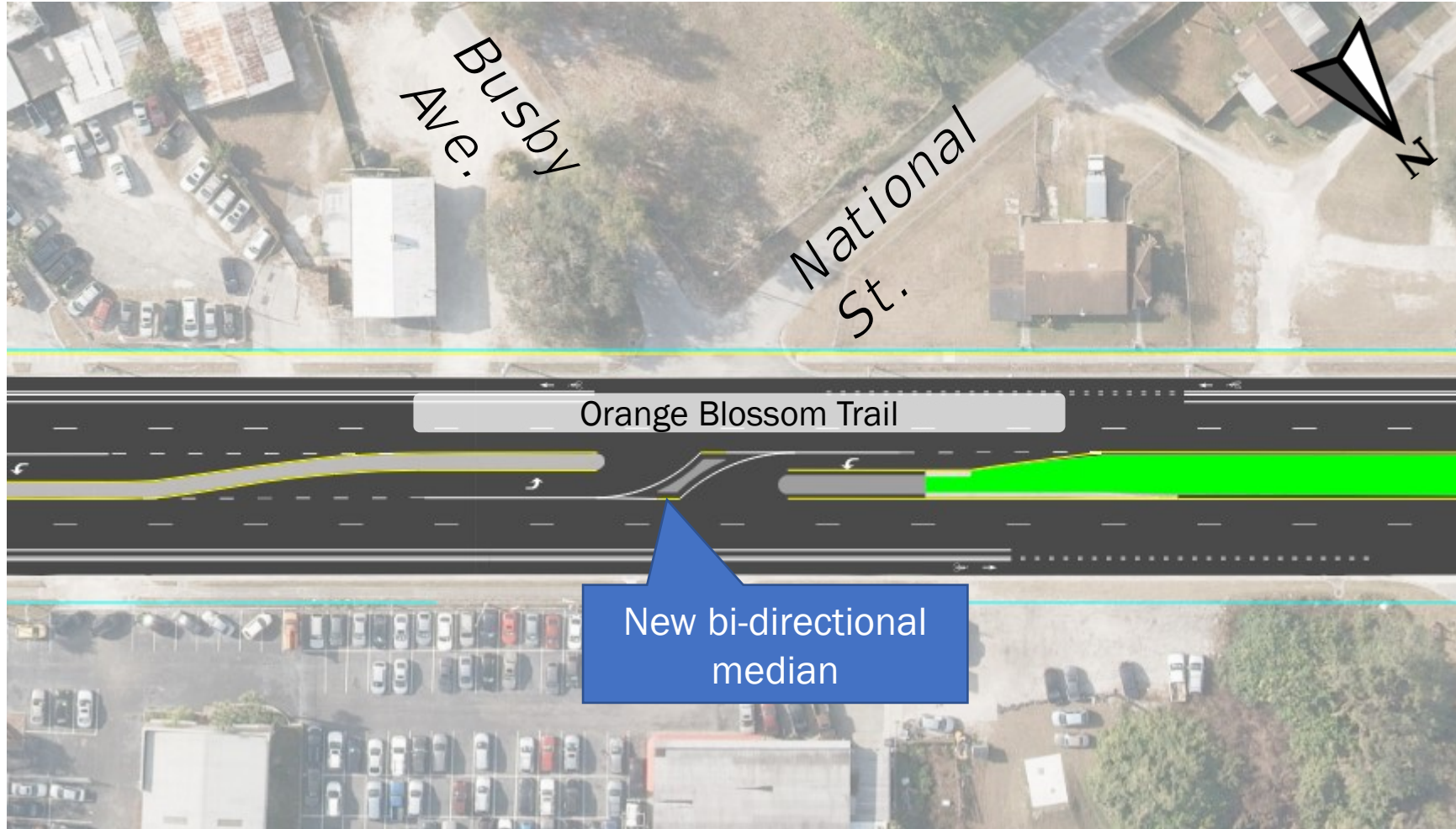

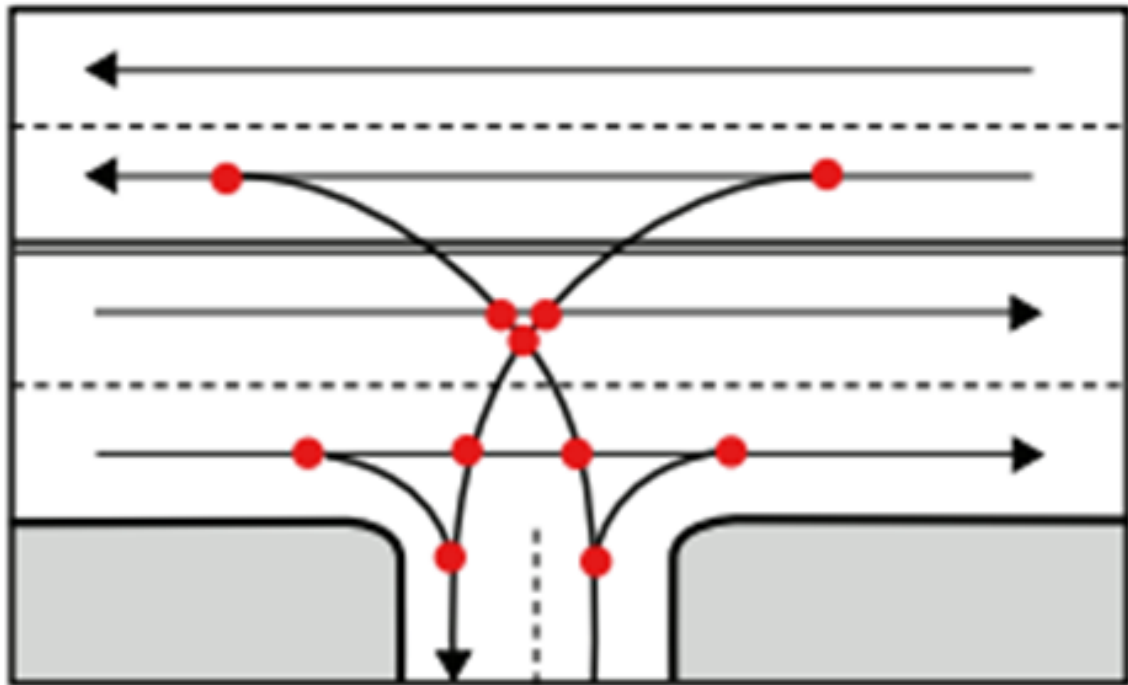

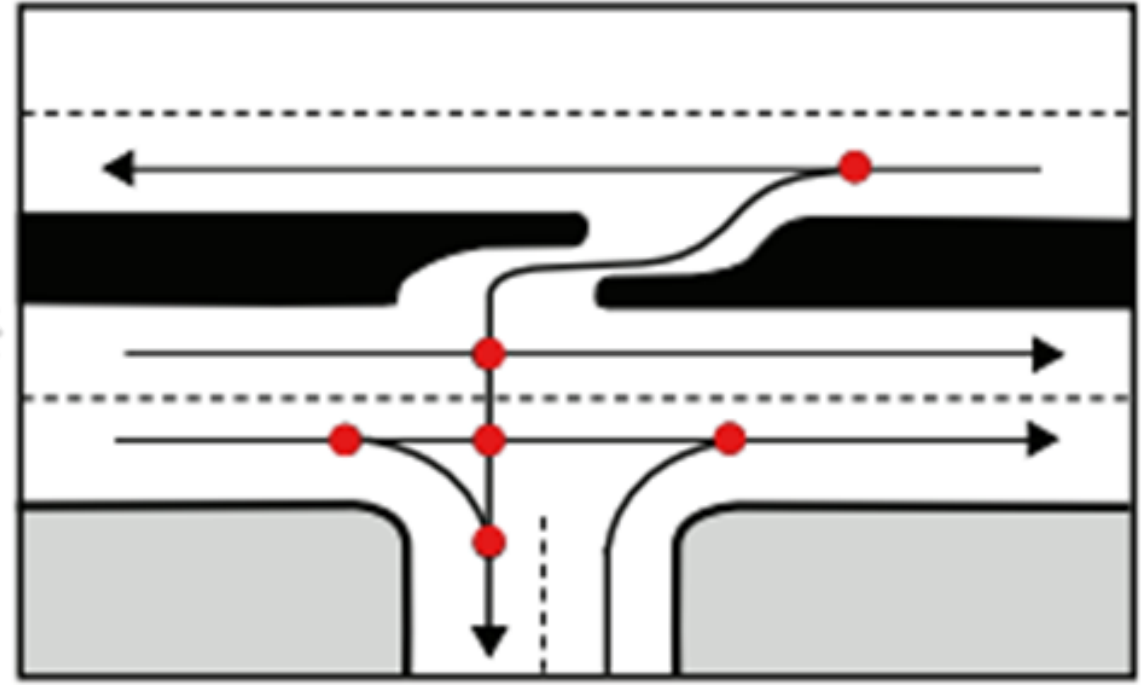

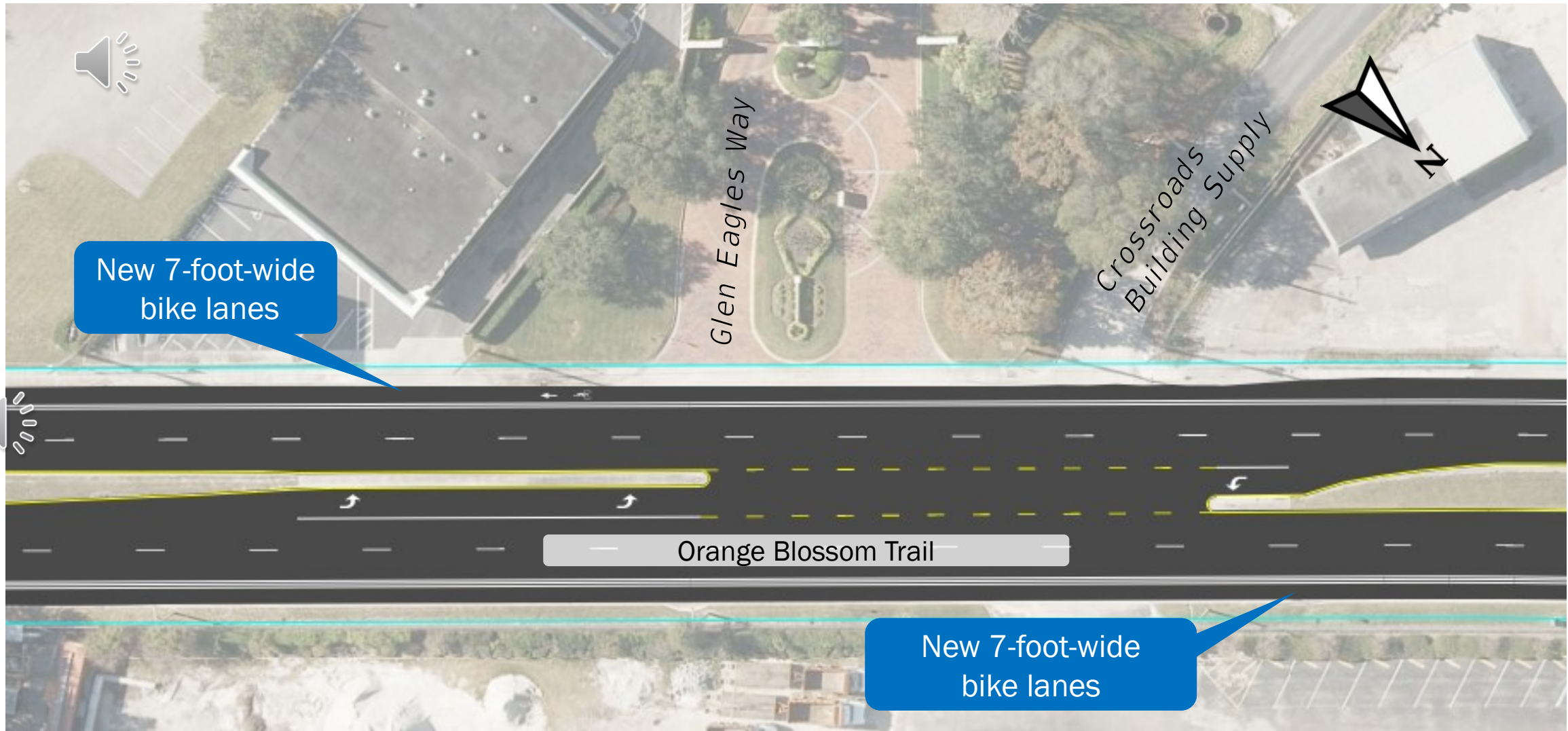

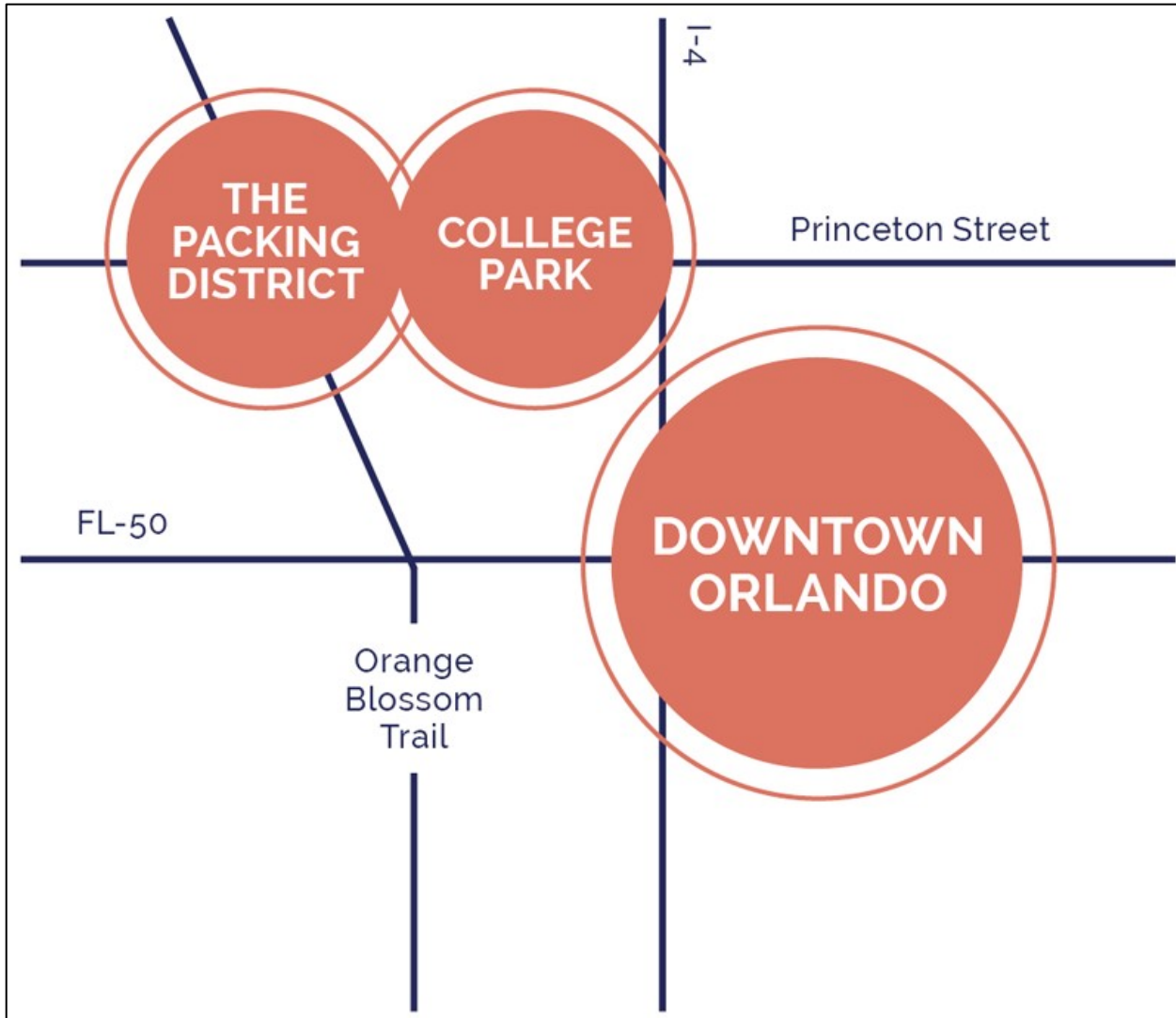
