Truck and Freight Site Analysis PD&E Study, Volusia County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on Truck and Freight Alternative Site Analysis Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study in Volusia County on Thursday, April 28, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to evaluate and recommend potential truck and freight parking site alternatives along the I-4 corridor that are viable for private and public operator use. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
