

East Lake Mary Boulevard (S.R. 415) at Sterling Meadows Way Safety Improvements

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety improvements at the intersection of East Lake Mary Boulevard (State Road (S.R.) 415) and Sterling Meadows Way in Sanford. These improvements will enhance the safety and efficiency of this intersection by improving traffic flow and reducing conflict points, or locations where a crash can occur.

Proposed improvements consist of converting the existing full median opening to a two-way directional median opening and extending the northbound left turn lane into True Health. These proposed improvements will allow U-turns and left

turns for vehicles traveling northbound and southbound along East Lake Mary Boulevard. Left turns from True Health and Sterling Meadows Way will be prohibited.

Signage and pavement markings will also be updated.
