BRIDGE REHABILITATION

S.R. 401 over Barge Canal Bridge

Brevard County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is painting and rehabilitating the State Road (S.R.) 401 movable bridges at Port Canaveral. In addition to painting, the three bridges will receive structural steel improvements, bridge deck improvements, and new span lock assemblies. A span lock assembly is a mechanical system that typically holds a movable bridge span in place when fully closed.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, one bridge will be closed at a time, and motorists will be asked to follow the designated detour routes. Once work is completed on one bridge, the detours will be adjusted to facilitate the closure of the next bridge. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and follow all detour signs.

Electronic message boards and other signage will direct traffic through the work zone. The level of work activity and noise will vary during different construction phases. Please note that the construction schedule is subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen conditions.
