



SOUTH ORANGE AVENUE (S.R. 527) SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT OPEN HOUSE

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a project open house regarding proposed improvements on **South Orange Avenue (State Road (S.R.) 527) east of Butler Drive at Cortland on Orange Apartments** on **Wednesday, February 19**, from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m., at **Unity of Central Florida Church, 771 Holden Ave., Orlando, FL 32839**.

The purpose of this project is to **enhance pedestrian safety by constructing a pedestrian-activated midblock crossing with a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB)**.
