

U.S. 192 Resurfacing Project From U.S. 27 to the Orange County Line

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to repave a segment of U.S. 192 (State Road 530) from U.S. 27 to the Orange County line. The purpose of the project is to maintain a safe and reliable travel surface.

In addition to resurfacing, planned improvements include:

- Restriping a section of westbound U.S. 192 to provide a dedicated right turn lane into Town Center Boulevard (west).
- Adding crosswalks at the intersection of U.S. 192 and Town Center Boulevard (east).
- Adding 6-foot-wide sidewalks on the north and south sides of U.S. 192 where none exist.



Roadway Restriping on westbound U.S. 192 approaching U.S. 27

- The right outside lane will become an exclusive right turn lane into Town Center Boulevard (west).
- Westbound U.S. 192 will transition from three lanes to two lanes.
- The middle lane will become the northbound entrance to U.S. 27.
- The left lane will become the southbound entrance to U.S. 27.
