

S.R. 40 Resurfacing From U.S. 17 to east of S.R. 11


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will resurface a portion of State Road (S.R.) 40 from U.S. 17 in Barberville to S.R. 11 in western Volusia County. The purpose of the project is to extend the service life of the roadway and maintain a safe and reliable driving surface.

In addition to repaving the road, the project will add safety features, including audible vibratory pavement markings on the outside edge lines, no parking signs by the Volusia Speedway, and warning signs at curves. Additionally, the project proposes to adjust the traffic signal at the intersection of S.R. 40 and U.S. 17 to provide a protected/permissive left turn arrow for traffic traveling from southbound U.S. 17 to eastbound S.R. 40.

Other work will reconstruct some side street connections to enhance safety for vehicles turning onto S.R. 40.

Construction is expected to begin in spring 2025 and last five to eight months. Drivers can expect single lane closures with flagging operations.
