Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to mill and resurface U.S. 27 (U.S. 441) from the Sumter County line to U.S. 301 (Abshier Boulevard) in Marion County. This resurfacing project is nearly 8.7 miles long. The purpose of this project is to maintain the roadway.

The project will also upgrade pedestrian curb ramps as needed to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
