

Truck & Freight Parking Facility Eastbound I-4

Volusia County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to build a new truck and freight parking facility along eastbound I-4, just over four miles west of I-95 in Volusia County. New entrance and exit ramps from I-4 will be built for access to the new facility.

The purpose of this project is to provide needed truck parking space to serve regional freight parking demand and enhance safety and mobility.

The truck parking facility will cover about 73.3 acres and have room for an estimated 275 truck parking spaces. It will include restrooms, landscaping, wildlife fencing, and wildlife sensitive lighting.

The location for this facility was one of five locations determined during a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study which was approved in summer 2024.

This project was selected for an Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) Grant Award which will fully fund the project and accelerate the project development timeline.
