

S.R. 40 Resurfacing From NE 25th Avenue to NE 64th Avenue

Marion County





Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing operational improvements on State Road (S.R.) 40 (E. Silver Springs Boulevard) from NE 25th Avenue to NE 64th Avenue in the City of Ocala.

The purpose of this project is to extend the service life of the existing roadway by repaving all travel lanes on S.R. 40 within the project limits. The project also proposes reconstructing

sidewalk to fill in small gaps on the eastbound and westbound sides. Any needed updates to pedestrian curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards will also be included. Existing pavement markings and signage along the corridor will be updated as necessary.

This project will be constructed with two other adjacent projects on S.R. 40 from U.S. 441 to NE 25th Avenue (FPID No. 450952-1).
