at Hastings Street/Sheringham Road





Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements at the intersection of Silver Star Road (State Road (S.R.) 438) and Hastings Street/Sheringham Road. The purpose of the project is to reconstruct and upgrade the existing traffic signal to improve operations and safety at the intersection.

The project will include new signal poles and signal heads to provide enhanced visibility for drivers. The project is also proposing to extend the left turn lane from eastbound Silver Star Road to Sheringham Road to improve the safety of those waiting to turn. New pedestrian signals will be installed and crosswalks will be realigned and restriped. Pedestrian curb ramps will be upgraded in accordance with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility.
