



Orange Avenue (S.R. 527) Maintenance Resurfacing

From North Magnolia Avenue to Colonial Drive (S.R. 50)

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans a maintenance resurfacing project on Orange Avenue (State Road (S.R.) 527) from North Magnolia Avenue to Colonial Drive (S.R. 50) in Orlando. The project will repave all travel lanes, except for a section from Marks Street to south of Park Lake Avenue where the road was recently resurfaced. Between North Magnolia Avenue and Garland Avenue, Orange Avenue accommodates two-way traffic. South of Garland Avenue, Orange Avenue is one-way southbound.

The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the existing roadway. This project also includes updating pedestrian curb ramps in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
