

State Road (S.R.) 434 Improvements From S.R. 414 to S.R. 436

Seminole County





Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning to resurface State Road (S.R.) 434 from S.R. 414 (Maitland Boulevard) to S.R. 436 to extend the life of the roadway.

This project also includes pedestrian enhancements such as restriping crosswalks and extending the nose of the medians past the crosswalk at the intersections of Lotus Landing Boulevard, West Town Parkway, and Orange Avenue (see graphic below). The extended nose protects pedestrians waiting on the median and slows turning drivers.
